As a Driver for Norwood and Brixton Foodbank, part of the Lambeth Foodbanks Partnership you will play a crucial role in ensuring delvieries are made across Lambeth and parts of Croydon. You will support the warehouse Manager Dispatch at busy times ensuring parcels are allocated to drivers and supporting the volunteer drivers as required.

You will work with Warehouse Manager stock to ensure all donations are collected and documented as to where they come from and support this team at busy times as required.

In addition, you will have responsibility for maintenance and upkeep of both the electric vans. Ensuring they are regularly cleaned inside and out, and vans sent for servicing and repair as required. Ensuring all drivers keep records of use and electric charge is kept up.

You will be involved in any additional requirements in securing leases for vans or additional vehicles
